Speech is an IESA affiliated extracurricular activity designed to provide you with a source of fun, entertainment, creativity, and self-expression. Below you will find the necessary information to get you on your way...

1. Complete the contract/practice schedule found on the back side of this page and return to Mr. Sylvester A.S.A.P.
Practices will begin the week of 9/9/19.
2. Begin thinking about which event (or events) you would like to participate in. (You can perform in up to 3 events).
3. After choosing your event/s, select a script from the club's collection, or begin writing your own original script.
4. Begin memorizing your lines right away. Speech is a relatively short season and the contest date arrives quickly!

Please indicate below which days of the week you will be able to practice. **Practices will be held Mondays-Thursdays from 2:45-4:00 p.m. in room 809 at the Junior High.**

We ask that students attend at least 2 of the 4 practices each week. Students may practice everyday if they choose. If performing with others be sure to consult with your partners on which days will work best for everyone. Other schedule arrangements (e.g. only being able to practice one day a week) can be discussed.

Practices will begin the week of 9/9/19. The season ends with the state competition on November 9th. Minooka Junior High is hosting this year, so no additional travel will be required.
